



Colonel Jean-Gabriel Herbinet

Head of the Digital and Data Branch within the French Army Staff

Colonel Herbinet possesses extensive experience in operational command at various levels, coupled with expertise in AI, data and digital domains. He currently serves as Head of the Digital and Data Branch within the French Army Staff.

He joined the armour branch after graduating from the Ecole Polytechnique in 1997. He held various positions as platoon leader and company commander between 1998 and 2004.

After an assignment as staff officer in the armour branch directorate in Saumur he had a general staff training between 2006 and 2009. During this training he also graduated from the ENSTA in Paris with an engineering degree and a MS in optimisation and operations research in 2008. From 2009 to 2012 he had a position as project officer in modelling and simulation where he was in charge of simulations for decision making support at the tactical (brigade) level and of interoperability between C2 systems and simulations. In 2012 he was assigned to the 3rd hussars regiment (light armoured battalion in the French German brigade) as executive officer. In 2014 he was transferred to urban warfare training centre as training director. From 2016 to 2018 he held the position of section head defence planning analysis in the NATO Allied Command Transformation where he took part to the long term military roadmap effort.

From 2018 to 2020 he commanded the urban warfare training centre – 94th infantry regiment in SISONNE. Then from 2020 to 2022 he served as chief of staff of the French German Brigade and VJTF22 brigade as part of NRF 22. At the summer 2022 he joined the army staff as deputy branch head and digital and data branch head. His branch is currently in charge of operationalising Data and AI in the French army.

He had various operational deployments in Lebanon (1999), in Bosnia (2000) and in Mali (2014).
